"WORLD TOUR of Contemporary Landscape Artists"

IPAP (International Plein Air Painters) and LAI (Landscape Artists International), who share a vision of promoting outstanding international contemporary landscape artists, are kicking off a new invitational traveling exhibition in June 2007. With the landscape as a common denominator, both organizations are joining forces in order to make this a truly remarkable world exhibition. For the inaugural 2007 WORLD TOUR of Contemporary Landscape Artists, the Signature members of IPAP and and Charter Members of LAI are invited to participate. Future tours will be juried and open to all members of both organizations.

Here's how the 2007 WORLD TOUR of Contemporary Landscape Artists, will work:

There will be a very limited number of venues with a "host" artist(s) at each location whose work will be added to the traveling portion of the show. Each host is responsible for finding and helping to arrange a quality exhibition space such as a museum or gallery that would suit our needs, as well as receiving shipped artwork and helping set up the show. Participating members from both LAI and IPAP will send one small painting for the traveling exhibit, to be replaced before the next venue if their painting is sold. Host artist(s) will be able to add a number of larger pieces at their location to help "fill out" the show. The first exhibit is scheduled in Newburgh, NY, USA at the Karpeles Library Manuscript Museum and we have been asked by the curator to do a two month show in June and July 2007.

Currently, plans for 2008 and beyond are underway. Once we work out the variables with the initial tour, we look forward to including more artists and additional venues.
